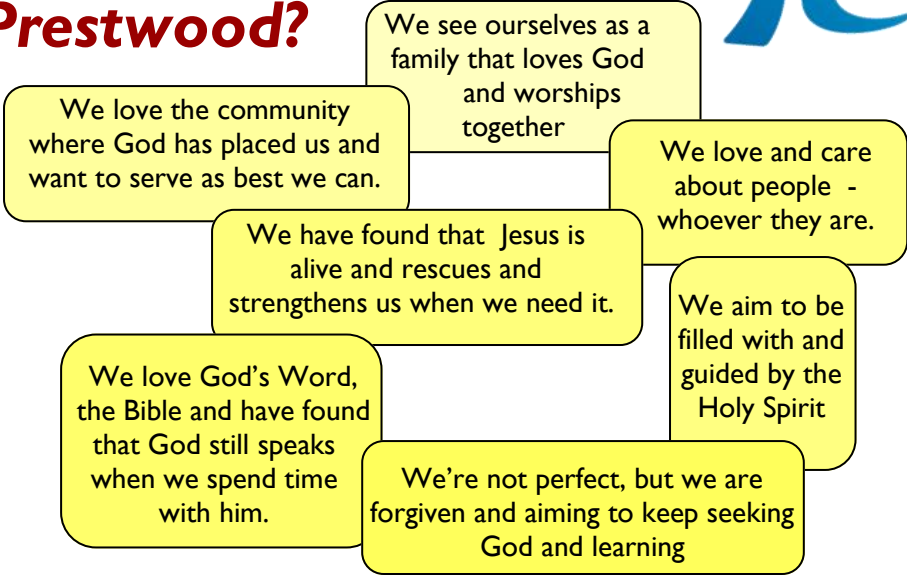
John ch. 6 vs. 28-35
